

# GL (GRANADA LEARNING): A Walkthrough

The GL External Exam in English and Math at Oscar Academy is a standardized assessment designed to evaluate students' skills and knowledge in the core subjects. It is used to measure student progress, benchmark performance against national or regional standards, and identify areas where additional support may be needed.

We prepare our students by integrating the GL competencies in the curriculum; conducting intensive trainings; using a variety of teaching methods, including hands-on activities, technology, and group projects, to make learning interactive and fun; developing essential 21st-century skills like problem-solving, digital literacy, and adaptability; and by providing guidance and resources to help students overcome challenges and celebrate achievements.

Trainings start from the beginning of the school year while the GL External exams are conducted each year in varying dates.

**YEAR 3** represents the end of Key Stage 1, providing an early early benchmark of foundational knowledge and skills.

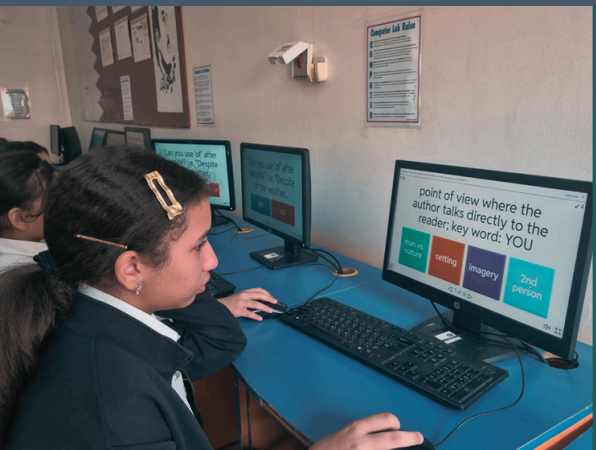
**YEAR 6** represents the end of Key Stage 2, allowing the school to evaluate academic readiness for the next educational phase.

Exams are conducted in a secure, monitored environment to ensure fairness and integrity.

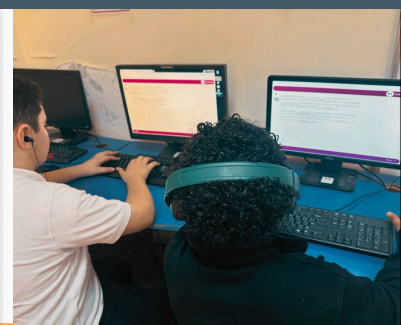
Students and parents are informed in advance about the exam schedule and preparation expectations. They usually vary from year to year.
